HOMEWORK PROCEDURE

EYFS

- All children in Reception and Nursery have a library book to take home which can be changed as regularly as they wish. They are not expected to be able to read this book independently but it is important to sit with them and discuss the pictures, read the story to them and ask them questions.
- When children are ready, a Read, Write Inc reading book will be sent home for them to read weekly. Please write in your child's reading record each time you listen to them read. This should be a minimum of 3 times per week.
- Weekly practical activities relating to the EYFS areas of learning are set on Class Dojo and photo evidence from parents/carers is encouraged.



YEARS 1-2

- All children have a library book which can be changed as regularly as they wish. They are not expected to be able to read this book completely independently but it is important to sit with them and discuss the pictures, read the story to them and ask them questions.
- When children are ready a Read, Write Inc reading book will be sent home for them to read weekly. Please write in your child's reading record each time you listen to them read. This should be a minimum of 3 times per week.
- All children in years 1-2 have a CGP book or a booklet made by school. This is sent home for completion on Fridays and is returned to school on Wednesdays for marking. The work set links to work completed in class during the week.
- Children in years 1-2 are encouraged to go on Numbots three times per week as a minimum.
- Children in years 1&2 will have spellings set weekly which are set based on their Dear, Write, Inc progression.



YEARS 3-5

- All children in years 3-5 have a CGP book or a booklet made by school. This is sent home for completion on Fridays and is returned to school on Wednesdays for marking. The work set links to work completed in class during the week.
- Children in years 3-5 have spellings to learn that are set on Purple Mash weekly.
- All children have a library book which can be changed as regularly as they wish.
- Children in years 3-5 will have a high interest reading book which can be changed weekly or a Read, Write Inc reading book. Please write in your child's planner each time you listen to them read. This should be a minimum of 3 times per week.
- Children in years 3-5 are encouraged to go on TTRS daily.



YEAR 6

- All children in year 6 have a CGP book or a booklet made by school. This is sent home for completion on Fridays and is returned to school on Wednesdays for marking. The work set links to work completed in class during the week.
- Children in year 6 have spellings to learn that are set on Purple Mash weekly.
- All children have a library book which can be changed as regularly as they wish.
- Children in year 6 will have a high interest reading book which can be changed weekly or a Read, Write Inc reading book. Please write in your child's planner each time you listen to them read. This should be a minimum of 3 times per week.
- Children in year 6 are encouraged to go on TTRS daily.
- Children in year 6 have tasks set on SATs Companion on a Monday which need completing by the following Monday.
