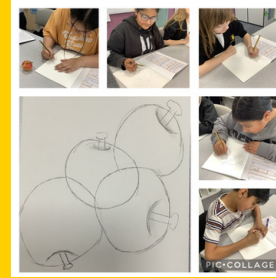


Message from Mrs McDonald



Dear Parents/Carers,

Last half term we fully implemented our new curriculum. I am so proud to see the children at Carlton Mills accessing an ambitious curriculum that enables them to get the skills and attributes they need to make them successful citizens in the future. From burrito making to Stone Henge being represented in biscuit form, our curriculum is now engaging, creative and helping children to develop a love of learning.



We are currently undertaking a year long CPD programme for the Equality, Diversity and Inclusion mark. Children are exposed to diversity through the curriculum and school actions, building and consolidating their knowledge and skills, developing positive attitudes about EDI and its value globally and to their own lives. In school, we have introduced Team Points to unite the children together to reach a common goal in their 3 different teams. Staffing announcements

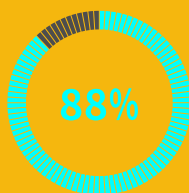

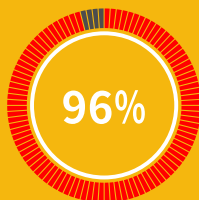
We welcome back Mrs Kauser from maternity leave in January. She will be working across school in a cover supervisor role.
