Mathematics

Topic: Addition and subtraction

Pupils will learn to:

- . Identify number bonds to ten
- . Identify number bonds to 100 (using tens)
- . Add and subtract ones
- Add and subtract tens
- Solve missing number problems

Topic: Shape

Pupils will learn to:

- Recognise 2D and 3D shapes ٠
- Count vertices on 2D and 3D Shapes
- Count faces and edges on 3d shapes .
- Use lines of symmetry to complete shapes

Topic: Science

Everyday materials

Pupils will learn to:

• Identify and compare the suitability of a variety of everyday materials, including wood, metal, plastic, glass, brick, rock, paper and cardboard for particular uses.

• Find out how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching.

Topic: Gymnastics Pupils will learn to: Travel in curled positions. Support my on body weight in curled positions. Stretch whilst in balance. Create a sequence which flows and involves arching and stretching. Create a sequence with seamless transitions between stretches and curls. Arch my body. Stretch and curl whilst performing a variety of gymnastic movements. Show inversion and counterbalance using the apparatus. Form front and back supports. Demonstrate a way of traveling into and out of supports. Perform a sequence with clear starts and finishes.


